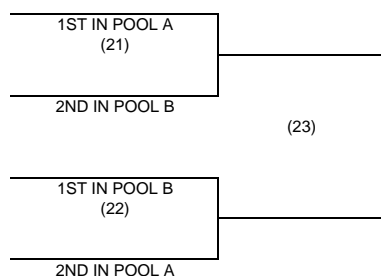

TRIPLE CROWN POOL PLAY RULES

- Two Way Tie: Same Pool
1. Win-loss record in pool play
 2. Head to head between tied teams

IMPORTANT: Point differential maximum

1. Forfeits will be scored 7-0
2. Maximum run spread per game is 7 regardless of score

THREE WAY TIE: SAME POOL

1. Head to head between tied teams IF one of the tied teams beat both teams they are tied with.
 - A. Then continue to seed remaining tied teams head to head
2. Total run differential IF all three teams beat each other.
 - A. Then continue to seed teams left in pool with run differential
3. Runs allowed
4. Runs scored
5. Coin Flip

TIE BREAKER SYSTEM:

If a game is tied after all innings have been completed, the California tie breaker rule will go into effect. Each team puts their last scheduled batter on second base and plays out the inning. This happens until the tie is broken and the game is complete.
